THE RATINGS:: This is the fourth set of **CCIR RANKINGS** for the 2017 Season. A lot of the ranked teams were not active invitational this past week and fewer will run in an invitational this week. Conference activity is the center stage along with rest & final sharpening.

Several teams ran their "b" team at invitationals last week. We tried to catch those that did. Some just had a player or 2 missing. Others have had an individual or 2 not run due to an injury or resting to prevent an injury. This makes it hard to really assess a team.

It is always interesting to watch the rematches that are going on during the season. There will be many rematches in conference meets, regionals & of course the Finals. How those rematches go and who is healthy on "the day" is always the fun part for the season.

We did not have time to do much with conference meets this week. Since so many will not run an invitational we will try to have conference meets in next week's issue.

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more than the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

We distribute the rankings each week. If your local paper would like to receive them, send us a name & email and we will include them on our list. The rankings are distributed each Tuesday evening. We are a day late this week.

The invitational part of the schedule is in full swing. Portage, Oakland County & Wayne County are the biggest meets on this week's schedule. The next week is full of invitationals with the following week having many conference meets or teams taking the Saturday off to get ready for the following week's regional meets.
