THE RATINGS::: This is the fifth set of CCIR RANKINGS for the 2017 Season. A lot of the ranked teams were not active invitational this past week and fewer will run in an invitational this week. Conference activity is the center stage along with rest & final sharpening.

There will be many rematches in conference meets, regionals & of course the Finals. How those rematches go and who is healthy on "the day" is always the fun part of the season.

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more that the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

We distribute the rankings each week. If your local paper would like to receive them, send us a name & email and we will include them on our list. The rankings are distributed each Tuesday evening. We are a day late this week.

The invitational part of the schedule is in full swing. Portage, Oakland County & Wayne County are the biggest meets on this week's schedule. The next week is full of invitationals with the following week having many conference meets or teams taking the Saturday off to get ready for the following week's regional meets.
