THE RATINGS:: This is the second set of the **CCIR RANKINGS** for the 2008 Season. The rankings are based on invitationals only! Ask meet managers to get us the results. We need to have results my Monday in order to make that week's issue. We have had good support from meet managers getting us the results. If you do not see a meet listed here please send us the results. After many years Kevin Hanson will not be doing the rankings for us and as a result we will do the rankings the same way we do the points, coaches votes and points according to how a team places in the invitationals it runs in. This will allow the girls to have a deeper "others" as the boys have had.

The rankings have points awarded according to how a team's finish in the invitational they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitationals. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coaches votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of seven, with only one being counted each week. The coaches vote each week.

We are starting to get the wrinkles out from doing both boys & girls rankings. We have the panels set and things seem to be working out. The biggest thing is to make sure we get all of the meet results. We actively contact all meet managers to get their results. The panel needs the invitational information to determine their vote. Most of the time when coaches question the rankings it is because we never received information on invitationals they were in. This especially hurts schools that have not been ranked in previous years.

The Superior 10 was not available this week. We hope it will be available in the future.
