THE RATINGS:: This is the third of the **CCIR RANKINGS** for the 2008 Season. The rankings are based on invitationals only! Ask meet managers to get us the results. We need to have results my Monday in order to make that week's issue. We have had good support from meet managers getting us the results. We actively contact all meet managers to get their results. The panel needs the invitational information to determine their vote. If you do not see a meet listed here please send us the results.

Things are begining to shake out in the rankings and there isn't as much jumping around is there is in the early week. It is interesting to watch teams that beat other teams early in the season and then loose to them later. It is interesting to see teams do well in smaller invaitonals and then stumble a little in the larger meets. Grouping, a weak 4 or 5 can make all the difference. The 30 team field at MIS is a lot different that the 13-16 team field of the region. That gap to 4 and/or 5 can all of a sudden add 50 or more points per runner. Then again that front runner, with the single digit palce, is a great helpespecially at MIS. A couple of teams have runners missing or instead of running 1 or 2 are not 4 or 5 or later right now. Then again there are teams that don't run hard each race. Looks like another interestin MIS shaping up.

The rankings have points awarded tohow a teams finish in the invitational they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitationals. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coaches votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of seven, with only one being counted each week. The coaches vote each week.

This wee we got the Upper Peninsula rankings. We got them after we had started to run pages off, so this week they are on the back page.
