THE RATINGS:: This is the first set of **CCIR RANKINGS** for the 2008 Season. We do not begin the rankings until this week as many teams do not begin competition until after Labor Day. The first week for ranking is always hard as many teams have had limited competition. The rankings are based on invitational results only! Ask meet managers to get us the results. We need to have results my Monday in order to make that week's issue. We have had good support from meet managers getting us the results. If you do not see a meet listed here please send us the results. After many years of Kevin Hanson doing the rankings for us we started doing the girl's rankings last year along with the boy's.

The rankings have points awarded according to how a teams finishes in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of seven, with only one being counted each week. Coaches vote each week.

Due to the death of Mary's mother I was out of town most of last week and Mary has been out of town most of the summer helping take care of her mother. As a result we did not completely have the ranking panel completely set up and did not get all of the votes this week. We expect to have a panel of 12/14 coaches voting. As with any year the first ballot is hard to come by. Many teams have just started their competition while others have had several meets. The unexpectedly strong team gains from our waiting to start the CCIR rankings as they are able to show their strength in competition.

The Superior 10 was not available this week. We hope it will be available in the future.
