Elite Michigan runners, Luke Humphrey and Clint Verran, will be battling it out again at the Solstice Run in Northville on Saturday, June 23rd. Humphrey and Verran are good friends and both qualifiers of the Olympic trials and have healed up from past injuries so are ready to race! Verran challenged Humphrey last week to run at the Solstice Run and Humphrey gladly accepted and both are running the 10 Mile event.

The two marathon titans competed against each other at the 2006 Boston Marathon. Verran placed 10th overall and Humphrey, who was close behind, placed 11th overall. Both have achieved 2:14 marathons and look for them racing with the Hanson's singlet. Verran recently won the 2012 Dexter-Ann Arbor Half-Marathon.

The 10 mile distance at the Solstice Run will be titled the "Duel in the Sun" with Verran and Humphrey seeking to become the overall winner and champion of the 10 Mile race event!
