This is the fourth set of rankings for the Michigan High School Cross Country Ratings, complied by CROSS COUNTRY I9INVITAITONAL RESULTS (CCIR). We have been doing this for close to 40 years. The rankings are based on invitational meet with a panel of coaches & points a team earns according to their place in invitationals.

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in the invitational in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. In the "others" the number in parenthese is the number of invitationals won. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more that the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

This past week was the last full week of invitaitonals as conferences are now into holding their final jamboree or conference meet this week. Mant teams will take the week off to begin preprations for the regionals that will be held next week. Several teams that did run an invitaitonal last week ran either a "B" team or did not run their entire team. Resting or maybe tryiking to avoind an injury. As a result there were some mixed results in the invitaitonals that were run. A few of the invitaitonals involved re-matches of teams with some chan ging order from a previous meet
