

Harbor boys first; Boyne City girls tie for first at East Jordan Track Invitational

EAST JORDAN - Boyne City's Katie Martin and Thereseann Zimmerman, East Jordan's Courtney Hammond, and Harbor Springs' boys' 1600-meter relay team set meet records Thursday to highlight the East Jordan Track and Field Invitational.

Martin and Zimmerman won two events apiece as the Ramblers tied Benzie Central, 90-90, atop the girls' team standings.

Harbor claimed six first places to win the boys' meet with 136 points. Charlevoix was a distant second at 74.5.

Martin set a meet record in the pole vault, clearing 10 feet, 6 inches, and won the 100-meter dash in a time of 13.48 seconds. Zimmerman's meet mark came in the 3200, where she finished in 11 minutes, 29.52 seconds. She was also first in the 1600.

In the process, Martin and Zimmerman also set school records in both of their respective events. Zimmerman's time in the 1600 was 5:16.7.

Hammond won the 400 and the 200, setting meet records in the process. Her 400 time was 59.57, and her 200 time was 26.89. Teammate Jessica Skop was also a double winner, taking the 100 hurdles and the 300 hurdles.

Harbor Springs, 80, was third in the 11-team girls' meet, followed by East Jordan, 74, and Charlevoix, 43.

Other area winners were Harbor Springs' Lisa Ward in the long jump; Harbor Springs in the 3200 relay; East Jordan in the 800 relay; and Harbor's Cassie Niersel in the 800 meters.

The Harbor boys set one meet record and two school marks in running away from the field. The Rams' 1600 relay won in a meet-record 3:33.01, while Mark Morse set a school mark in going 11-7 in the pole vault, breaking the 11-year-old record of 11-6; and Josh Hofbauer broke his own record in the 3200 when he finished second in 9:32.65. His previous mark, set at last year's state meet, was 9:41.

Other first for Harbor in Thursday meet came from James Loubert, discus; Morse, high jump; Aris Adams, 800; Danny Eggars, 200; and the 3200 relay.

Charlevoix had two winners with Kyle Kramer in the 110 hurdles and Jeff Urban in the 100.

Randall Sutton was Boyne City's lone winner, taking the long jump. The Ramblers finished seventh with 41 points and East Jordan, with 21, was 10th in the 11-team field.

Central Lake's Stephan Shay set meet records in winning the 1600, 4:23.44, and 3200, 9:32.65.
