THE RATINGS::: This is the second set of **CCIR RANKINGS** for the 2017 Season. Most of the teams are now competing so we have multiple meets for most teams so our evaluation is better. D4 still doe not have a lot of teams with more than one invitational making it hard to get a handle on many of the D4 teams. Many of the D4 teams compete with larger schools and finish at the bottom of the standings so you do not get a real look at them. By this time of the season we are starting to see teams that finished behind another team earlier finish ahead in the rematch. That will happen more and more as the season progress making a little harder to rate one team ahead of another. So who is better.....

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more that the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

We distribute the rankings each week. If your local paper would like to receive them, send us a name & email and we will include them on our list. The rankings are distributed each Tuesday evening. We are a day late this week.

The invitational part of the schedule is in full swing. Portage, Oakland County & Wayne County are the biggest meets on this week's schedule. The next week is full of invitationals with the following week having many conference meets or teams taking the Saturday off to get ready for the following week's regional meets.
