The Class D & Northern Michigan were the only real large invitationals last week. This always gets interesting in Division 4 and to a lesser extent in Division 3. As other fall sports wind down many D4 and D3 teams are now able to run a full team for some of the first times. As aresults teams that often "dnf" in many invitationals during the season. We did not get many conference jamboree results in as not as many results that we got this year were in a convient form to use, so it took longer to get results into CCIR, sorry.

Rankings are based on invitational results only! Ask meet managers to get us the results. We need to have results by Monday in order to make that week's issue. We have had good support from meet managers getting us the results. If you do not see a meet listed here please send us the results.

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more that the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

We distribute the rankings each week. If your local paper would like to receive them, send us a name & email and we will include them on our list. The rankings are distributed each Wensday evening.
