THE RATINGS::: This is the third set of CCIR RANKINGS for the 2021 Season. We usually want it out Wednesday evening, but did not finish until Thursday AMwe got this set out on Wednesday.

Things were a little bit quitter this week as there were not as many invitationals. Teams are starting to pull back and/or conferences are scheduling their conference meet or final conference jamboree in preparation for the coming regional weekend,

There are still a significant small invitationals with only 4-6 teams which we do not include in CCIR unless onne division has more that 6 teams. An invitational must have more that 6 or more team to be considered in the rankings.

Rankings are based on invitational results only! Ask meet managers to get us the results. We need to have results by Monday in order to make that week's issue. We have had good support from meet managers getting us the results. If you do not see a meet listed here please send us the results.

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more that the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

We distribute the rankings each week. If your local paper would like to receive them, send us a name & email and we will include them on our list. The rankings are distributed each Tuesday evening.
