THE RATINGS::: This is the first set of **CCIR RANKINGS** for the 2021 Season. Sorry, we missed last week when we usually start them. We normally release the rating on Wednesday, the first one took longer this year so we are a day late this week.

Most of the teams have had at least 3 or 4 meets, giving everyone a good look at them. Several teams took the week off or used their "B" team. Next week is the Portage Invitational which will give a good look at all divisions mostwill race in their own division. D1 will not have as good a look as 2 of the largest counties will be hosting their County Championships. This means Oakland County & Wayne County will not have their teams competing at Portage. Most of the schools in those counties are D1 so the impact will be limited to D1. There are a few meets that will keep a few others from Portage.

The smaller divisions, especially D4 are still a problem. Many of those schools share athletes with another sport so you do not always have the complete team when they run. Many, when the do run their full team, are really competitive and figure into championships.

The next couple of Saturdays will have a full schedule of invitationals. After that teams start competing in their conference schedule and start preparations for the regional meet which is in 4 Saturdays.....

Rankings are based on invitational results only! Ask meet managers to get us the results. We need to have results by Monday in order to make that week's issue. We have had good support from meet managers getting us the results. If you do not see a meet listed here please send us the results.

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more that the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

We distribute the rankings each week. If your local paper would like to receive them, send us a name & email and we will include them on our list. The rankings are distributed each Tuesday evening.
